ROYAL OPERA HOUSE BRIDGE

This funding is **OPEN FOR APPLICATIONS FROM SWALE SCHOOLS** to support creative projects/programmes. Focusing on a collaborative framework, multiple schools must work together and build additional funding streams to further support their project. Criteria for application:

- Applications seek between £1,000-£2,500
- 50% of required funds for your project need to be raised/identified by other means
- Responds to an identified need
- Demonstrates clear school leadership commitment (a contract will need to be signed by a Headteacher)
- Work must support a minimum of 3 named schools
- A fund holding partner is clearly identified in the application
- Your application explains how you will evaluate the impact of the project
- Applications from attendees of 'Fundraising Workshop' and 'Virtual Sugeries' prioritised

TURNER | PORTFOLIO X RISE UP CLEAN UP ONLINE




